

- (2) If a candidate is nominated for more than one office, he or she must declare either their intention to be considered for both positions, or their intention to be considered for only one position, as well as which position, in writing to the Electoral officer no less than 45 days before the election.
- (3) If a candidate has declared their intention to be considered for both Grand Chief and Deputy Grand Chief and is elected as Grand Chief, that candidate will automatically be withdrawn from consideration for Deputy Grand Chief.

All confirmed candidates that meet the requirements as stipulated in the NAN Election Procedures including their Nominator and Seconders are:
